THE FLEET IN BALBOA PARK

With the intent of remaking its signature Balboa Park experience, the Fleet has presented ever-changing, always amazing, transformative science experiences through exhibitions such as Taping Shape and Science Fiction, Science Future, in addition to popular IMAX® films, including *Jerusalem* and *National Parks Adventure*.

THE FLEET AT YOUR SCHOOL

To inspire science exploration in the classroom, Fleet educators went on the road to deliver science programming to kids in their schools. Educators also provided professional development opportunities for teachers where they received training, tools and programmatic support for topics such as engineering in the classroom and science in children's literature.

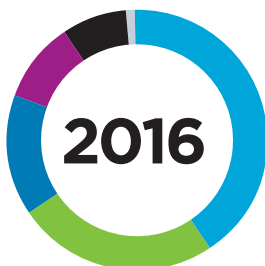


THE FLEET IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

In its role as the central link between science and our communities, the Fleet took to the streets, bringing adult programs such as Two Scientists Walk Into a Bar, Say Cheese! and Crossover: Where Comics and Science Meet! into local neighborhoods. In October 2015, the Fleet launched 52 Weeks of Science, a program that unites 56 STEM organizations to offer free science events each week in Barrio

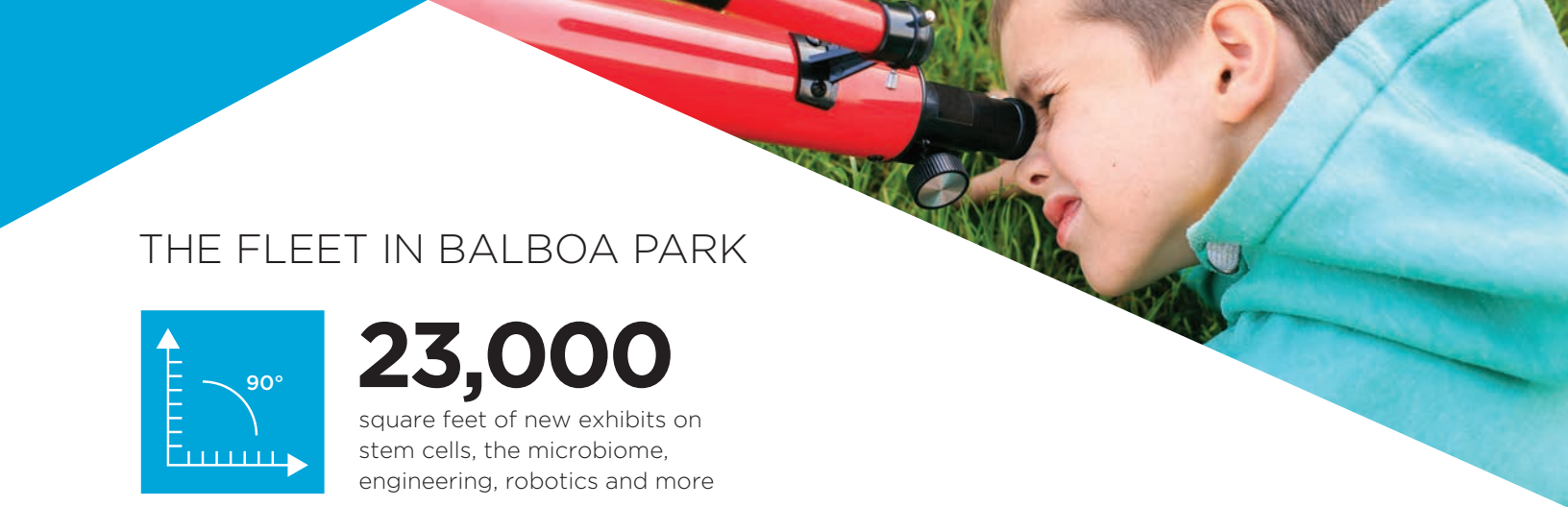

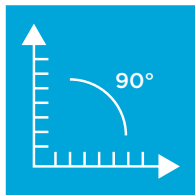
